Existing wedding bands can be used and handed around the gathering in a cloth, and held as each person gives their blessing and wishes for the future. A Renewal of Vows or Re-Affirmation Ceremony can also include a commemorative certificate. This can be signed by two witnesses at the event. Unlike a legal ceremony, people of any age even children can be the signatories at this ceremony. The format of a Renewal of Vows Ceremony can be similar to a wedding ceremony or can have a unique structure as chosen by the couple. You may wish to renew your vows as a celebration of the evolution of your relationship, or as a ceremony for people who were unable to attend your wedding.
